

Adult Literacy

The Island Partnership offers training and qualifications in adult literacy. Learning is largely through Learndirect on-line courses, with tutor support available, if and when felt to be appropriate. The qualifications offered by The Island Partnership are OCR (Oxford, Cambridge and RSA Examination Board) certificates in Adult Literacy.

The OCR Certificate in Literacy (available at Levels 1 and 2) is a nationally recognised qualification for basic skills at Levels 1 and 2 of the National Qualifications Framework. This qualification is approved for use by 16-19 learners and adults.

To gain certification at levels 1 and 2 candidates must pass an exam. These are multiple choice tests that are externally set by QCA (Qualifications and Curriculum Authority) and marked by OCR.

The course includes:

- Reading skills
- Writing skills
- Vocabulary, spelling and grammar

This course is suitable for adults who wish to improve their skills and qualifications in literacy, whether they need to demonstrate these skills for further learning or to find employment. Upon successful completion of the course the candidate will receive an OCR certificate at the appropriate level.

Duration: flexible, up to, approximately, 1 year.
